Long; Nyquist and Associates
Marketing Proposal

Manager Greene explained Long, Nyquist and Associates had provided a proposal to work closely with the City on the marketing of the City and the Airport Industrial Park or any other area of concern. The fee was \$4,000.00 a month for a one year contract.

Council expressed their opposition to the fee amount.

The proposal died for lack of a motion.

There were no Council comments.




Mayor Geyer made the following announcements:
