CITY STREETS TO BE CLOSED FOR PARADE

City of St. Marys residents are reminded that many of the downtown streets and the Diamond will be closed to vehicle traffic on Saturday, September 16, 2017, beginning at 11:00 a.m. and continuing for the duration of the 175th Anniversary Parade (approximately 3 hours). Below is a detailed listing of the streets that will be affected:

Louis Street, Center Street, North Michael Street (from Center Street to Parade Street), Parade Street, North St. Marys Street (from Parade Street to Railroad Street), South Michael Street (from Bruxelles Street to Depot Street), and Depot Street (from South Michael Street to Fourth Street), North Michael Street (from the Apollo Theatre to Depot Street), as well as around the Diamond (North St. Marys Street to South St. Marys Street and Railroad Street).

There will be limited vehicle access on Maurus Street.

Anyone trying to navigate through St. Marys during this time is encouraged to utilize side streets and allow time for delays.
